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1. Legislation and statutory guidance

Governing boards of maintained schools must have an instrument of government which sets out information about how the board is constituted. This requirement is set out in [the School Governance \(Constitution\) \(England\) Regulations 2012, part 5, regulation 28](#).

2. Instrument of government

1. The name of the school is **Poulner Junior School**.
2. The school is a **maintained community school**.
3. The name of the governing board is 'The governing board of **Poulner Junior School**'.
4. The governing board shall consist of:
 - a. **Two** parent governors
 - b. **One** local authority governor
 - c. **One** staff governor
 - d. **One** headteacher
 - e. **Eight** co-opted governors
5. The total number of governors is **thirteen**.
6. This instrument of government comes into effect on **8th March 2018**.
7. This instrument was made by order of Hampshire County Council on **8th March 2018**.
8. A copy of the consolidated instrument will be supplied free of charge to every member and associate member of the governing board (including the headteacher where they are not a governor).
